Self-assessment consent checklist pre Implant Removal

I understand the old implant will be removed using a small amount of local anaesthetic injection, a small cut will then be made over the end of the implant and the implant will be removed -possibly with the use of forceps.	
I understand that if the implant is difficult to feel or seems to be pressing on a nerve or blood vessel removal may not be possible at the appointment and I may be referred to another clinic.	
I understand that if having a new implant it will either be inserted through this hole or if we need to change the site, another small amount of anaesthetic will be used and the new implant will be inserted.	
I understand that my fertility should return to whatever it would normally be within a few days after removal if no implant is replaced.	
I understand that following the removal procedure: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• I am likely to have bruising and discomfort around the insertion site for up to a week• I need to keep the area dry until the small wound is healed- usually 3-4 days• Insertion and removal of implants will leave a small scar	
There are some very rare but serious risks including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Nerve damage of the arm• Blood vessel damage These risks are minimal when fitted by a registered and experienced practitioner
